The Honourable Nomusa Dube-Ncube is the Member of the Executive Council responsible for the Finance portfolio in the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Government. She was previously with the Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs in the Province. She served as a Member of the Executive Council for Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs for two terms between 2009 and 2019. She holds a Masters degree in Public Administration from the University of KwaZulu-Natal.

She serves as a Member of the KwaZulu-Natal Climate Change Council and also as a Board Member for the 911 Fund - a New York-based Non-Profit Organisation, established by former US President Barack Obama in the wake of one of the most devastating disasters in modern history and human development, the aerial attack on the landmark Twin Towers in New York in 2001.
