NATIONAL TREASURY SCM CIRCULAR 14 OF 2016/2017: AMENDMENT OF STANDARD BIDDING DOCUMENT (SBD 6.1 AND 6.2) IN RESPECT OF PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM AND LOCAL CONTENT IN TERMS OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2017 AND THE IMPLEMENTATION GUIDE.

On 03 April 2017, National Treasury issued Circular 14 of 2016/17: amendment of standard bidding document (SBD 6.1 and 6.2) in respect of preference points claim form and local content in terms of the preferential procurement regulations 2017 and the implementation guide. Accounting Officers and Accounting Authorities must take note of and comply with the Circular.

Regulation 6(2) and Regulation 7(2) provide a table for the award of B-BBEE points per B-BBEE status level of contributor. This table in the Preferential Procurement Policy Regulations 2011 was amended to align with the new B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice in the 2017 regulations. As a result B-BBEE points allocated in terms of 80/20 preference point system have been reduced for level 3 B-BBEE status level of

Contributor from 16 to 14. B-BBEE points allocated in terms of 90/10 preference point system have been reduced for level 3 B-BBEE Status level of Contributor from 8 to 6.

In line with the provision of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017, Institutions are requested to review and update their SBD 6.1 documents.

Changes to SBD 6.2 were effected to align with the provisions in Regulation 8 of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.

The Circular, implementation guide and the revised SBD forms have been published on the KZN Treasury website under SCM Instruction Notes.
