Data Source and Reliability

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This report uses data reported by municipalities by the 10th working day of the month, as required in Section 71(1) of the MFMA. The report has been compiled based on information provided by the municipalities in the form of mSCOA data strings, Financial Management Reports (FMR) and other budget performance information for the financial period ended 31 March 2022 from the NT LG Database. Therefore, any queries on the budget, revenue or expenditure figures reflected in the report must be referred to the relevant Municipal Manager or Chief Financial Officer. The quality of the report depends on the reliability and credibility of the information and figures submitted by the municipalities. It is noted that certain municipalities experience challenges with their financial systems as well as with the capturing of financial data in accordance with the mSCOA segments. These problems cause errors in the submitted data strings as well as inaccuracies in the financial information related to misalignment, cash flow and balance sheet budgeting.

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Methodology and Approach

The methodology and approach used for the compilation of this report included the following:

The data for the analysis used in this report was extracted from the NT LG Database as reported by municipalities for the financial quarter ended 31 March 2022. The non-delegated municipalities, namely, the eThekweni Metro and the Msunduzi and uMhlathuze Local Municipalities are included in the report. By the time of extracting the third quarter financial information from the NT LG Database on 21 April 2022, some municipalities may not have corrected the errors in their monthly MFMA Section 71 performance data strings. Such errors may have distorted the reporting of the budget performance as at the end of the third quarter for the respective municipalities, the district totals and the aggregated provincial total.

All municipalities should have generated and spent approximately 75 percent of their 2021/22 Adjusted Budgets as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.

1. Introduction

This consolidated municipal budget performance review covers the financial performance of municipalities in KZN as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year ended 31 March 2022.

The consolidated statement provides the in-year financial performance of municipalities against their budgeted revenue and expenditure. It includes the operating and capital budget performances as well as the debtors, creditors and conditional grant reporting requirements.

Assessing the expenditure performance of municipalities assists in serving as a control and management tool and serves as an early warning signal for identifying financial problems.

This is the third financial year that the report is prepared using the figures from the mSCOA data strings. The mSCOA Regulations were promulgated on 22 April 2014 and prescribed the uniform recording and classification of the municipal budget and financial information at a transaction level. The mSCOA Regulations require that municipalities upload their budget and financial information in a data string format to the Local Government portal across the six mSCOA regulated segments. The quarterly report has been prepared using the mSCOA data strings submitted by the municipalities, however the credibility of the information contained in the data strings is of concern. At the core of the challenge are the following:

- The incorrect use of the mSCOA segments and municipal accounting practices by municipalities;
- A large number of municipalities are not budgeting, transacting and reporting directly in/from their core financial systems. Instead they prepare their budgets and reports on excel spreadsheets and then import the excel spreadsheets into their financial system; and
- Municipalities are not locking their Approved Budgets annually on their financial systems. Furthermore, their financial systems are not being locked at month-end to ensure prudent financial management.

Legislative Framework

In terms of Section 71(7) of the MFMA, *the Provincial Treasury must, within 30 days after the end of each quarter, make public as may be prescribed, a consolidated statement in the prescribed format on the state of municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity. The MEC for Finance must submit such consolidated statement to the provincial legislature no later than 45 days after the end of each quarter.*

2. District Overview

2.1 Operating Revenue

- In aggregate, municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal generated *Operating revenue* amounting to R59.9 billion or 77.3 percent of the Adjusted Budget of R77.6 billion as at the end of March 2022. The revenue generated is above the expected straight-line projection of 75 percent at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The eThekweni Metro with R33 billion or 55 percent contributed the most to the total *Operating revenue* of R59.9 billion followed by the uMgungundlovu District with R6.2 billion or 10.4 percent. This can be attributed to the Msunduzi Local Municipality having reported R4.5 billion or 68.9 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R6.5 billion as at the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The King Cetshwayo District contributed R4.6 billion or 7.7 percent to the total *Operating revenue* of R59.9 billion which can be attributed to the uMhlathuze Local Municipality having reported R3 billion or 72.9 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R4.2 billion.
- The Harry Gwala District with R1.4 billion or 2.3 percent contributed the least to the total *Operating revenue*. This is due to the Harry Gwala District having the lowest Adjusted Budget of R1.5 billion which equates to 2 percent of the Total Adjusted Budget of R77.6 billion. It should however be noted that municipalities in the Harry Gwala District reported to have generated 89.2 percent of their Adjusted Budgets of R1.5 billion as at 31 March 2022.
- The *Service charges – electricity* revenue line item contributed the most towards *Operating revenue* as R17 billion or 28.3 percent was generated as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year. *Other revenue* of R2.3 billion or 3.9 percent contributed the least towards *Operating revenue* generated and it is made up of *Rental of facilities and equipment, Interest on external investments and outstanding debtors, Dividends received, Fines, penalties and forfeits, Licenses and permits, Agency services and Gains*.

2.2 Operating Expenditure

- In aggregate, municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal incurred *Operating expenditure* amounting to R55.1 billion or 69.8 percent of the Adjusted Budget of R79 billion as at the end of March 2022. The expenditure incurred is below the expected straight-line projection of 75 percent at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The eThekuni Metro with R31.8 billion or 57.7 percent contributed the most to the total *Operating expenditure* of R55.1 billion followed by the uMgungundlovu District with R5.3 billion or 9.6 percent. This can be attributed to the Msunduzi Local Municipality having reported R4 billion or 60.8 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R6.2 billion as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The King Cetshwayo District contributed R4.4 billion or 8 percent to the total *Operating expenditure* of R55.1 billion which can be attributed to the uMhlathuze Local Municipality having reported R3 billion or 68.1 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R4.3 billion.
- The uMkhanyakude District with R1.1 billion or 2 percent contributed the least to the total Operating expenditure of R55.1 billion. This is due to the uMkhanyakude District having the lowest Adjusted Budget of R1.6 billion which equates to 2.1 percent of the Total Adjusted Budget of R79 billion.
- The *Employee related costs* line item contributed the most towards total *Operating expenditure* as R16.3 billion or 29.6 percent was spent as at the end of third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year. *Employee related costs* is a material component of the costs of delivering services to the communities served by municipalities. *Remuneration of councillors* of R569.3 million or 1 percent contributed the least towards *Operating expenditure*.

2.3 Capital Revenue

- Municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal generated *Capital revenue* amounting to R11.2 billion or 88.4 percent of the Adjusted Budget of R12.7 billion at an aggregate level to fund their *Capital expenditure* as at the end of March 2022. The revenue generated is above the expected straight-line projection of 75 percent at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The uMgungundlovu District with R5.7 billion or 50.8 percent contributed the most to the total *Capital revenue* of R11.2 billion. The high *Capital revenue* generation rate reported by the uMgungundlovu District was mainly attributed to the Msunduzi Local Municipality having incorrectly reported R5.6 billion or 860.5 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R655.2 million up to the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year due to incorrect reporting. The error has distorted the provincial average.
- The eThekuni Metro was the second highest contributor with R2.2 billion or 19.7 percent whilst the King Cetshwayo District was the third highest contributor with R649 million or 5.8 percent of the total *Capital revenue*.
- The uMkhanyakude District with R146.3 million or 1.3 percent contributed the least to the total *Capital revenue* of R11.2 billion. The low generation of revenue by the uMkhanyakude District was mainly attributed to the uMkhanyakude District Municipality having reported R49.4 million or 16.7 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R295.6 million. The reason for the low *generation of Capital revenue* by the uMkhanyakude District Municipality is mainly attributable to the delay in the approval of the 2021/22 Original Budget which had a negative impact on the implementation of the Capital budget, hence lower *Capital revenue* recognised.
- The highest contributor towards the total *Capital revenue* as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year was *Transfers recognised – capital* at R9.5 billion or 84.6 percent (this was due in the main to the Msunduzi Local Municipality having incorrectly reported R4.9 billion) followed by *Internally generated funds* at R880.7 million or 7.8 percent. The *Borrowing* of R853.6 million or 7.6 percent contributed the least towards the total *Capital revenue* during the first three quarters of the 2021/22 financial year.

- Municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal incurred *Capital expenditure* amounting to R11.6 billion or 91.3 percent in aggregate against the Adjusted Budget of R12.7 billion as at the end of March 2022. The expenditure incurred is above the expected straight-line projection of 75 percent at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- The uMgungundlovu District with R6.1 billion or 52.2 percent contributed the most to the total *Capital expenditure* of R11.6 billion. The high *Capital expenditure* reported by the uMgungundlovu District was mainly attributed to the Msunduzi Local Municipality having incorrectly reported R6 billion or 912.8 percent against the Adjusted Budget of R655.2 million up to the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year due to incorrect reporting. The error has distorted the provincial average.
- The eThekini Metro contributed the second highest to the Total *Capital expenditure* with R2.2 billion or 19 percent while the uMkhanyakude District reported the least *Capital expenditure* of R172.4 million or 1.5 percent. The reason for low Capital expenditure by the uMkhanyakude District Municipality is mainly attributable to the delay in the approval of the 2021/22 Budget which had a negative impact on the implementation of the Capital budget.
- The bulk of the total *Capital expenditure* as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year was spent on *Road transport* with R4.8 billion or 41.1 percent with the uMgungundlovu District contributing the most in this category with R2.7 billion or 57.2 percent, once again due to the incorrect reporting by the Msunduzi Local Municipality. The third highest contributor towards *Capital expenditure* was *Electricity* with R2.8 billion or 24 percent.
- The lowest contributor towards total the *Capital expenditure* category was *Other* with negative R144.7 million or negative 1.2 percent as a result of the eThekini Metro incorrectly reporting negative R475.3 million *Other Capital expenditure* as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- A total amount of negative R8 million was also reported for *Housing Capital expenditure* as a result of the Msunduzi Local Municipality incorrectly reporting negative R173.7 million in this category.

- The Total debt owed to municipalities at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year was R35.9 billion which represents an increase of R1.5 billion or 4.4 percent from the R34.3 billion reported by municipalities as at the end of the second quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- At the end of the third quarter, a substantial amount of debt totalling R29.4 billion or 82.1 percent was outstanding in the *Over 90 Days* category, representing an increase of R380.5 million or 1.3 percent from R29.1 billion reported in the same category as at the end of the second quarter of the 2021/22 financial year. As at 31 March 2022, the Debtors per age category were as follows: *0-30 Days*: R3.7 billion or 10.4 percent; *30-60 Days*: R1.6 billion or 4.5 percent; and *60-90 Days*: R1.1 billion or 3 percent.
- The uMdoni, the uMngeni and the eMadlangeni Local Municipalities show nil Debtors outstanding as at 31 March 2022 due to the uMdoni and uMngeni Local Municipalities submitting Debtors Monthly M09 data strings showing nil Debtors, whilst the eMadlangeni Local Municipality submitted its Debtors Monthly M09 data string with errors. As a result, Total Debtors balance are understated.
- The Debtors Age Analysis by *Customer group* indicates that a considerable portion of debt is owed by *Households* at R24.8 billion or 69.2 percent followed *Commercial* at R7.4 billion or 20.6 percent.
- Debt collection efforts must focus on these long outstanding debts, however some of these Debtors may still need to be written off as they may have arisen as a result of the incorrect billing of Indigent customers, amongst others. Municipalities are encouraged to update their Indigent registers to determine households that qualify for rebates and discounts with the aim of ensuring that Debtors are accurately billed and reported. The continued increase in the level of debt owed to municipalities is noted with concern as the municipalities should be implementing effective debt management and credit control measures in order to improve their Debtors collection rates, which in turn will have a positive impact on their cash flows.

2.6 Creditors Age Analysis

- The total debt owed by municipalities at the end of the third quarter was R5.8 billion which represents a decrease of R568.1 million or 9 percent from the R6.3 billion owed by municipalities as at end of the second quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- At the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year, a substantial amount of debt totalling R1.9 billion or 32.3 percent was outstanding in the *Over 90 Days* category, representing a decrease of R941.5 million or 33.6 percent from R2.8 billion reported in the same category as at the second quarter of the 2021/22 financial year. It is concerning that 41.8 percent of the debt owed by municipalities, which amounts to R2.4 billion was outstanding for longer than 30 days in contravention of Section 65(2)(e) of the MFMA.
- The uMkhanyakude District reflected a negative Creditors balance of R45.8 million in the 0 to 30 Days category. The negative Creditors' balance was as a result of the Mtubatuba and Big Five Hlabisa Local Municipalities and the uMkhanyakude District Municipality reporting negative R25.6 million, negative R6.2 million and negative R14.2 million amounts against Creditors in the 0 to 30 Days category respectively. According to the Big Five Hlabisa Local Municipality and the uMkhanyakude District Municipality, the negative amounts are as a result of debit order payments that automatically go through their bank accounts on the last day of the month whilst invoices would be received and raised on the financial system after the payments have gone through. With regards to Mtubatuba Local Municipality, the negative reporting against Creditors is mainly due to challenges being experienced with their financial system and which is being addressed with the financial system service provider.
- The eNdumeni and the eMadlangeni Local Municipalities reported nil Creditors outstanding as at 31 March 2022 due to the eNdumeni Local Municipality submitting Creditors Monthly M09 data string

showing nil Creditors, whilst the eMadlangeni Local Municipality submitted its Creditors Monthly M09 data string with errors. As a result, Total Creditors are understated.

- The majority of the outstanding *Creditors* relate mainly to *Bulk electricity* of R1.8 billion or 31.9 percent followed by *Bulk Water* of R1.6 billion or 27.3 percent of total *Creditors*.
- Of the *Bulk electricity* outstanding *Creditors* balance of R1.8 billion, R466.3 million was in the *Over 90 Days* category. This was mainly due to the fact that the Mpofana, Msunduzi and Ulundi Local Municipalities reported amounts in the *Over 90 Days* category owing to Eskom of R280.6 million, R87.1 million and R98.5 million respectively for unpaid electricity. Due to the poor collection of outstanding Debtors, the municipalities experienced cash flow challenges and were therefore unable to make full payment on invoices owed to Eskom. At the date of the preparation of this report, Provincial Treasury had not yet received a copy of the Eskom March 2022 MFMA Section 41 report. According to the Eskom February 2022 MFMA Section 41 report in respect of the Mpofana Local Municipality, Eskom has indicated that an out of court settlement discussion is in progress, that the municipality put forth a proposal to start paying the current account from May 2022 and that a payment arrangement will be negotiated before active partnering can commence; for the Msunduzi Local Municipality, Eskom has indicated that on 03 March 2022, a payment arrangement was concluded; and for the Ulundi Local Municipality, Eskom has indicated that the payment arrangement was not honoured, the Intergovernmental Relations Framework Act 13 of 2005 (IRFA) process was initiated and a breach notice was issued on 10 March 2022.
- The Newcastle and eNdumeni Local Municipalities did not report the balances owed to Eskom in their MFMA Section 71 data string however, as per the Eskom February 2022 MFMA Section 41 report it was noted that the Newcastle and eNdumeni Local Municipalities owed Eskom R199.2 million and R47.8 million for unpaid Bulk electricity respectively as at 28 February 2022. The Newcastle Local Municipality has a signed repayment plan with Eskom on the bulk account which is being honoured, whilst in respect of the eNdumeni Local Municipality, the IRFA process is active, CoGTA is acting as mediator and the municipality's cash-flow is currently being reviewed. Provincial Treasury is also part of the mediation team.
- Of the *Bulk water* outstanding *Creditors* balance of R1.6 billion, R725.6 million was in the *Over 90 Days* category. This was mainly due to the fact that the King Cetshwayo District Municipality, the Ugu District Municipality and the Msunduzi Local Municipality reported amounts owing to the Umgeni Water Board of R344.3 million, R233.9 million and R119.5 million respectively for unpaid Bulk water in the *Over 90 Days* category.
- A notice of intention to restrict the water supply was issued to the King Cetshwayo District Municipality as a result of lack of payment towards the long outstanding amounts to Umgeni Water. Further correspondence has been issued in March 2022 for which a response is awaited. Should this fail then bulk water restrictions will be pursued per the notice issued in October 2021.
- Umgeni Water in their March 2022 MFMA Section 41 report for Bulk Water indicated that in respect of the Ugu District Municipality, they received R14 million in February 2022, that revised payment plan scenarios are being prepared for repayment of the overdue balance taking into account customer affordability and should this revised payment plan not be complied with, bulk water restrictions will be pursued in accordance with the letter issued in October 2021.
- The Msunduzi Local Municipality indicated that they have been hampered by low cash flows as a result of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. They have therefore not been able to pay all of their third party service providers; however, they have recently communicated that they have successfully entered into a payment arrangement with the Umgeni Water Board. Umgeni Water in their March 2022 MFMA Section 41 report for Bulk Water indicated that it accepted this payment plan on the 28 February 2022 and is currently monitoring payments against this plan.
- The uThukela District Municipality did not report the balance owed to the Umgeni Water Board in their MFMA Section 71 data string, however as per the Umgeni Water March 2022 MFMA Section 41 report it was noted that the uThukela District Municipality owed the water board R264 million for unpaid Bulk water, the overdue amounts are subject to the mediation process in terms of the IGR and a payment of R2 million was received on 06 April 2022 by the Umgeni Water Board from the uThukela District Municipality.

- In terms of the Division of Revenue Act, Act No. 4 of 2021 (DoRA), direct allocations to all 54 municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal, including the eThekini Metro amounted to R7.3 billion, while allocations in-kind amounted to R715.5 million, totalling R8.1 billion. Municipalities have reflected spending of R2.7 billion or 37.1 percent against the total direct allocation of R7.3 billion.
- The total Municipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) allocation to all the municipalities within the province was R3.4 billion, excluding allocations to the uMhlathuze and Ray Nkonyeni Local Municipalities as well as the eThekini Metro. The eThekini Metro receives the Integrated City Development Grant (ICDG) while the uMhlathuze and Ray Nkonyeni Local Municipalities receive the Integrated Urban Development Grant (IUDG), therefore none of these municipalities receive the MIG allocation.
- As at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year, a total of R1.4 billion or 42.4 percent was spent of the total MIG allocations to the applicable municipalities.
- The total IUDG allocation to the Ray Nkonyeni and uMhlathuze Local Municipalities was R210.9 million, of which R140.2 million or 66.5 percent was spent when compared to the allocations to the two municipalities as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- According to the 2021 Division of Revenue Act (DoRA), the Integrated City Development Grant (ICDG) has been repurposed into the Programme and Project Preparation Support Grant (PPPSG). The eThekini Metro was allocated R49.9 million for this grant for the 2021/22 financial year but has not reported any spending against the allocation as at the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year.
- A total of 19 municipalities reported under-expenditure against their MIG allocations for the 2021/22 financial year. A further eight municipalities reported no expenditure against their MIG allocations while six municipalities reported negative expenditure against their MIG allocations. The negative performance reported was due to incorrect reporting by the Ugu and uMgungundlovu District Municipalities as well as the Okhahlamba, uMhlabuyalingana, Mtubatuba and Nkandla Local Municipalities.
- The total Water Services Infrastructure Grant (WSIG) allocation to the municipalities within the province was R897.1 million. As at the end of the third quarter, a total of R290.9 million or 32.4 percent was spent when compared to the allocations to municipalities. The following municipalities did not

report any expenditure against their allocations and contributed to the under-spending of the WSIG namely: the uMhlathuze Local Municipality as well as the uMgungundlovu, uThukela and uMkhanyakude District Municipalities. The Msunduzi Local Municipality reported negative R13.8 million against the WSIG allocation due to errors in the data strings.

2.8 Criteria for determining serious financial problems

Section 138 of the MFMA specifies criteria for determining serious financial problems. As per Section 138 of the MFMA, the following factors, singly or in combination, may indicate a serious financial problem:

- (a) *The municipality has failed to make payments as and when due;*
- (b) *the municipality has defaulted on financial obligations for financial reasons;*
- (c) *the actual current expenditure of the municipality has exceeded the sum of its actual current revenue plus available surpluses for at least two consecutive financial years;*
- (d) *the municipality had an operating deficit in excess of five per cent of revenue in the most recent financial year for which financial information is available;*
- (e) *the municipality is more than 60 days late in submitting its annual financial statements to the Auditor-General in accordance with Section 126 [of the MFMA];*
- (f) *the Auditor-General has withheld an opinion or issued a disclaimer due to inadequacies in the financial statements or records of the municipality, or has issued an opinion which identifies a serious financial problem in the municipality;*
- (g) *any of the above conditions exists in a municipal entity under the municipality's sole control, or in a municipal entity for whose debts the municipality may be responsible, and the municipality has failed to intervene effectively; or*
- (h) *any other material condition exists which indicates that the municipality, or a municipal entity under the municipality's sole control, is likely to be unable for financial reasons to meet its obligations.*

Additionally, Section 140 of the MFMA specifies criteria for determining serious or persistent breach of financial commitments. As per Section 140(2) of the MFMA, the following factors, singly or in combination, may indicate that a municipality is in serious material breach of its obligations to meet its financial commitments:

- (a) *The municipality has failed to make any payment to a lender or investor as and when due;*
- (b) *the municipality has failed to meet a contractual obligation which provides security in terms of Section 48 [of the MFMA];*
- (c) *the municipality has failed to make any other payment as and when due, which individually or in the aggregate is more than an amount as may be prescribed or, if none is prescribed, more than two per cent of the municipality's budgeted operating expenditure; or*
- (d) *the municipality's failure to meet its financial commitments has impacted, or is likely to impact, on the availability or price of credit to other municipalities.*

The purpose of In-Year-Monitoring (IYM) of the Section 71 reports is amongst others, to serve as an early warning system to identify and assist municipalities facing financial problems, including any emerging or impending financial problems. Thus, in line with Sections 138 and 140 of the MFMA, National Treasury developed a set of criteria to identify municipalities that have serious problems.

The criteria consider amongst others:

- The audit outcome of the most recent annual audit by the Auditor-General;
- Creditors balance of over R1 million that are owed for more than 90 days;
- Significant/Large Operating deficits; and
- Negative cash position for two consecutive years.

Provincial Treasury has utilised the criteria as developed by National Treasury to monitor municipalities that display one or more of the indicators of serious financial problems on a quarterly basis based on the MFMA Section 71 reports.

The results of the assessment against the above criteria are set out in Annexure J. However, the reliability and credibility of the MFMA Section 71 reports are a serious concern for KZN Provincial Treasury due to the quality of the data strings submitted by municipalities. It is noted that certain municipalities experience challenges with their financial systems as well as with the capturing of financial data in accordance with the mSCOA segments. These problems cause errors in the data strings submitted by municipalities as well as inaccuracies in the financial information relating to cash flow (reflecting unrealistic Cash and cash equivalents balances) and balance sheet budgeting. As a result, some of the municipalities identified as having serious financial problems based on the MFMA Section 71 reports are questionable. For example, 33 municipalities in the province have been flagged as meeting the criteria for having serious financial problems based on the quarter three MFMA Section 71 figures, however, upon further scrutiny, 19 of the municipalities (list and details as reflected in Annexure J) actually do not appear to have financial problems due to the following:

- The data strings of three (3) of the 33 municipalities are incorrect due to inaccurate reporting by the municipalities;
- The existence of Creditors over R1 million that are owed for more than 90 days are due to disputes with service providers for seven (7) of the 33 municipalities, while the municipalities have the financial means to settle those Creditors;
- The negative audit opinion was the only criteria displayed for three (3) municipalities however, these municipalities do not display any other signs of financial problems as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year;
- The Operating deficit was the only criteria displayed for two (2) municipalities however, these municipalities do not display any other signs of financial problems as at the end of the third quarter of the 2021/22 financial year;
- The existence of Creditors over R1 million that are owed for more than 90 days are due to Retentions for two (2) municipalities which distort the overall Creditors balance;
- The existence of Creditors over R1 million that are owed for more than 90 days is mainly due to amongst others, the inclusion of Short-term debt in the Creditors balance for two (2) municipality which distorts the overall Creditors balance.

The remaining 14 municipalities have been identified as meeting the criteria for having serious financial problems as shown in Table 10.

Included in the list of the 14 municipalities identified as meeting the criteria for having financial problems, seven (7) municipalities listed in Table 11 have also been identified as being in financial distress by National Treasury. These municipalities are also under intervention in terms of Section 139(1)(b) of the Constitution.

Provincial Treasury has planned to support six (6) of the seven (7) municipalities in financial distress whilst the remaining one (1) municipality, Msunduzi, being a non-delegated municipality, is being supported by National Treasury. Finance experts have been deployed to the uMkhanyakude, uThukela and uMzinyathi District Municipalities as well as the Mpofana Local Municipality. The Finance Experts will support the municipalities during the 2022/23 financial year. Financial management support will continue at the Mtubatuba Local municipality during the 2022/23 financial year. The AbaQulusi Local Municipality declined the Financial Management Support offered to them for the 2022/23 financial year as the municipality has appointed their own consultants.

The support to be provided for the 2022/23 financial year has already commenced during the latter part of the 2021/22 financial year.

The remaining seven (7) municipalities shown in Table 12 also meet the criteria for having financial problems based on the financial performance as at the end of quarter three of the 2021/22 financial year and will need to be closely monitored going forward.

It is important to note that 11 of the 14 municipalities identified as meeting the criteria for having financial problems also have unfunded 2021/22 Adjusted Budgets as shown in Table 13. Some of these municipalities have also credible Updated Budget funding plans which are being monitored by Provincial Treasury. Although, the remaining three (3) municipalities have funded 2021/22 Adjusted Budgets, namely; the Msunduzi Local, eMadlangeni Local and Mtubatuba Local Municipalities, they still meet the criteria of having serious financial problems as mentioned above.

2.9 Non Compliance with the MFMA Reporting Requirements

KZN Provincial Treasury uses the monthly In-Year reports, creditors, debtors and conditional grants reports to produce the MFMA Section 71(7) Consolidated Municipal Budgets Performance Report. As at 19 April 2022, two (2) municipalities did not submit their data strings for Month 09 within 10 workings days after the end of March 2022 as required by Section 71(1) of the MFMA and were therefore issued with non-compliance letters. Subsequent to Provincial Treasury officials engaging the non-compliant municipalities, one (1) of the two (2) municipalities submitted their data strings and the other one still did not submit their required data strings as at 25 April 2022. The non-compliant municipalities for Months 09 are listed in Table 14 below.

2.10 Conclusion

Whilst Provincial Treasury would continue supporting municipalities, the primary responsibility to avoid, identify and resolve financial problems in a municipality rests with the municipality itself as per Section 135(1) of the MFMA. It is therefore incumbent upon the political and administrative leadership at the municipalities to be vigilant with regard to early identification of financial problems that would threaten their service delivery obligations.
